The next day the whole **team** set off to the village, but during their **journey** Mowgli was captured by the band of **monkeys**.

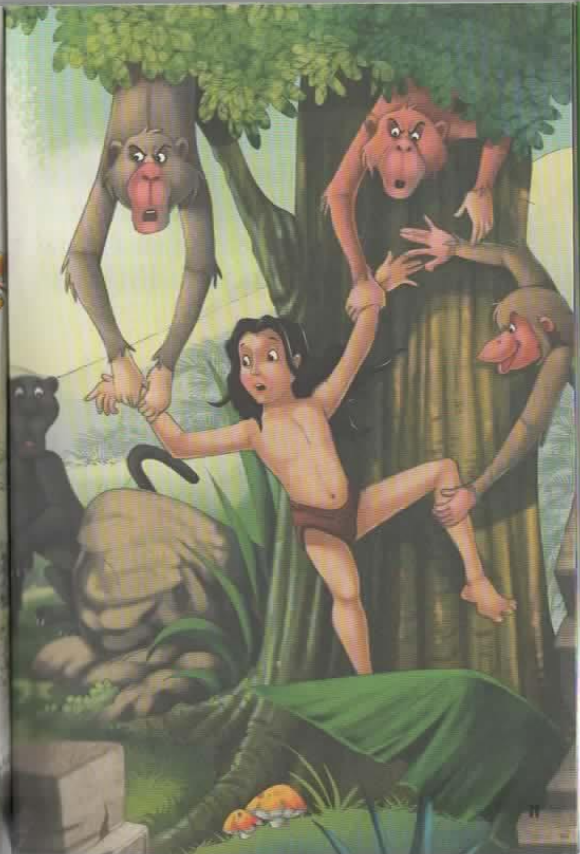

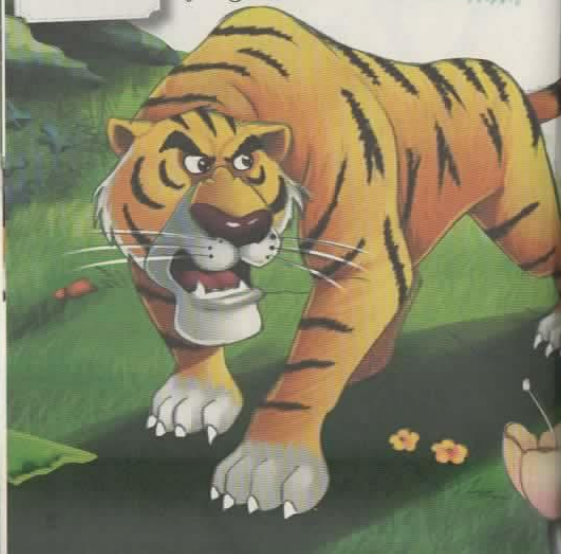


escape - ucieczka

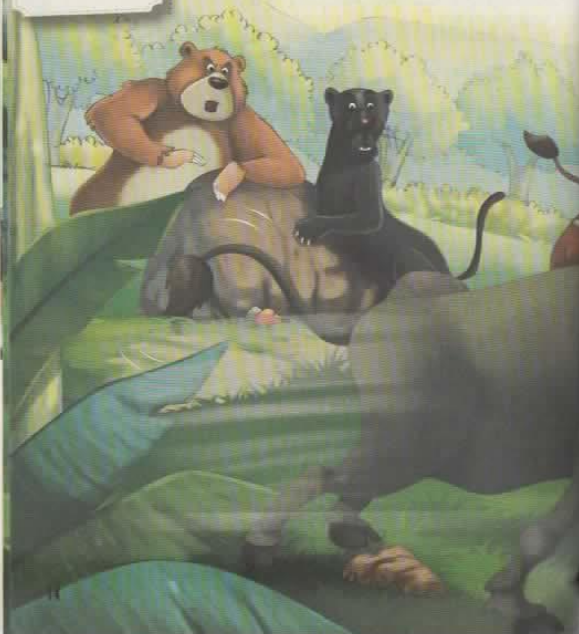


enemy - wróg

So he made a plan to attack the **enemy** with **buffaloes**. He met with them on the top of the **mountain** and gave them the signal to run down.

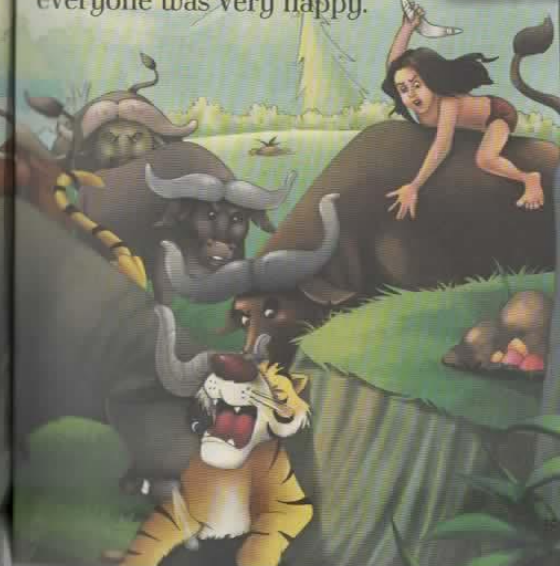
